FOOD BOOTH AGREEMENT
MAY 7 & 8, 2010

Thank you for your involvement with our festival. Please read and follow all instructions listed below. Please note changes to our agreement. We will be charging a flat fee of \$250 per vendor and only twelve (12) vendors will be accepted. This includes Non-Profit organizations. Previous vendors will have priority over new vendors. Vendors must submit their menu for consideration. The Yell Fest committee reserves the right to strike any menu item to avoid duplications. After your menu has been received and approved, you will be notified of acceptance. Any vendor needing to cancel will need to contact the Dardanelle Chamber of Commerce prior to April 1, 2010 to be considered for a refund. Refunds will be considered on an emergency cancellation basis only. Vendors will be allowed to set up on Thursday May 6th between the hours of 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. You will not be allowed to serve food until Friday. Be advised that security will not be provided on Thursday. Due to parking and space issues, R.V's or campers will not be allowed to park at Riverfront Park. R.V's will be welcome at all State Parks and camp grounds. All vendors must be set up by 12:00 p.m. Friday May 7th. Vendors will be responsible for any electrical supplies needed. The Dardanelle Chamber of Commerce is not responsible for any electrical accidents should the vendor attempt to connect to an electrical outlet on their own. All vendors will be required to stay until 10:00 p.m., Saturday, May 10, 2008. There will not be a need for any settlement with the Chamber of Commerce. You will be responsible for clean up of your area after the festival is over.

It is hereby agreed between the Dardanelle Chamber of Commerce, and _____, owner, manager, or, agent of _____, that said establishment shall offer for sale on May 7& 8 2010 food and/or drinks as indicated below. Your establishment agrees to abide by all city and state health codes. Booths are to be self-contained. The Dardanelle Chamber of Commerce will not be responsible for injury, illness, or accident associated with the sale of your establishment's product. Vendors will be responsible for the neat appearance of their personnel and facility.

Food & beverage items to be sold: (Only one major item per vendor, such as hamburgers, barbeque, etc.)

(You will not be allowed to sell corndogs, cotton candy, candy apples, caramel apple slices, corndogs, and nachos. Those items are exclusive to the carnival)

Your flat fee includes 30 amp-240 volt or 120 volt 20 amps. For 240 volt 50 amp add \$25.00, above 50 amps will have to be negotiated before the event.
